Fundraising

The Ballard Performing Arts Booster Club helps to raise funds to support the students and directors of all performing arts programs. The annual fee goes to the Associated Student Body (ASB) fund. The Music Department annual fee covers the cost of our operating expenses—sheet music, festival fees, transportation, t-shirts, instrument repair, and uniform cleaning and maintenance. ASB funds cannot be spent to pay for coaches, clinicians or guest instructors. These items, along with student scholarships, are the bulk of the BHS Performing Arts Booster Club budget. Funds for this budget come from our fundraising events, matching funds, sponsorships, merchandise sales, and passive fundraising. The Booster Club also sponsors fundraising events for students to help raise money for their student accounts. Passive Fundraising Programs

Now that BHS Performing Arts Booster Club is an official 501c3 organization, we are now eligible for many new and easy fundraising opportunities. *Easy Ways to Support BHS Performing Arts Booster Club at No Cost to You!*

Ballard Market Receipts – Save your receipts from Ballard Market and turn them into the box marked Ballard Market Receipts in the music room by the black mailbox or in the main school office. Ballard Market donates 1% of your purchases back to BHS Performing Arts Booster Club. This was our #1 passive fundraiser of 2015-16. We raised over \$2,000.00.

Fred Meyer – register online at fredmeyer.com/communityrewards. If you only sign up for one program, make this one it. Rewards Customers still get the rewards points, fuel points and, rebates. Choose *Ballard High School Performing Arts Booster Club* (or 82494) as the organization for community rewards. After registering, rewards will accrue each time you use your card or enter your phone number with purchases at all Fred Meyer locations. Signing up will not change any of your other Fred Meyer rewards points or gas points.

If you're already enrolled, and did not re-enroll to support BHS PABC by June 30, 2016, your choice organization was dropped on July 1. You may re-enroll your Rewards Card by visiting fredmeyer.com/communityrewards and clicking the "Link your Rewards Card Now" tab. BHS PABC received over \$800 from this program in 2015-16.
